Adeline Tan (a.k.a. Mightyyellow) is an illustrator and visual artist. Adeline's works draw inspiration from her surroundings and popular culture, often juxtaposing elements derived from personal experiences and memory alike. She has worked on campaigns for Adidas, Uniqlo, Lululemon, Formula One, the Singapore Tourism Board, Facebook and Hewlett Packard, among others. Her works have also been exhibited in Singapore, Hong Kong, Taipei and the UK, and have appeared in publications including DigitalArts Online, Wall Street Journal Asia and the Straits Times.
